1. Completed 2011 Juried Art Application
2. One image of booth and three images of work labeled with Artist name, medium, dimensions.

The WAJF will only accept digital images. Please provide a CD with four images in JPEG format, 100 DPI or less, approximately 1 MB (please do not submit Flash, PowerPoint, or Kodak picture CDs), along with a list that includes artist name, medium, and dimensions. Unless accompanied by a stamped, sel-addressed envelope, CDs will not be returned.

3. A \$70.00 juried single booth fee (10' x 10') or \$110.00 double booth fee (10' x 20'). Please make checks payable to "Wooster Arts Jazz Fest."

to submit an application to the Wooster Arts Jazz Fest (WAJF) which features a juried fine art and crafts festival, jazz, quality food, a traditional New Orleans-style parade, and free children's arts activities.

The WAJF is presented through a partnership of Main Street Wooster, Inc., Rotary Club of Wooster, the Wayne Center for the Arts and the Wooster City Schools.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Exhibit set up time: Saturday, September 17, 2011 from 8:00-11:00 a.m. All exhibits must be in place by 11:00 a.m.
2. Exhibition Hours: Saturday, September 17, 2011 from 11:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m. Artists must be off the street by 8:30 p.m.
3. Work may not be moved from the assigned space before 7:00 p.m..
4. The person whose work is accepted must be present during the WAJF.
5. The WAJF Committee is not responsible for any loss or damage to property of participating artists and their coworkers.
6. Exhibitors must furnish their own display and protective materials such as tents, tables, chairs, display walls, etc.
7. Electrical service is not available.
8. The WAJF suggests a broad pricing range.
9. The WAJF takes **no percentage of exhibitor profits.**
10. WAJF exhibitors are selected strictly on merit as interpreted by an independent jury.

MEDIA

Artists may enter any of the following media: ceramics, digital art, drawing, enamel, fiber, glass, jewelry, leather, metal, mixed media, painting, paper, photography, printmaking, sculpture, wood.

All work exhibited is to be the original work of the artists. Quality commercial reproductions of the artist's original work may be displayed and sold. Reproductions must be signed editions and labeled "reproduction." The exhibiting photographer must print photographs. Molded ceramics must be made from artist-designed molds.

Artists displaying work not consistent with these requirements or with submitted slides will be asked to remove disputed work. The WAJF committee reserves the right to close any booth that is not in compliance with these written policies.

AWARDS

Artist works will be judged by independent, on-site jurors beginning at 11:00 a.m., and ribbons will be awarded by 2:00 p.m.
